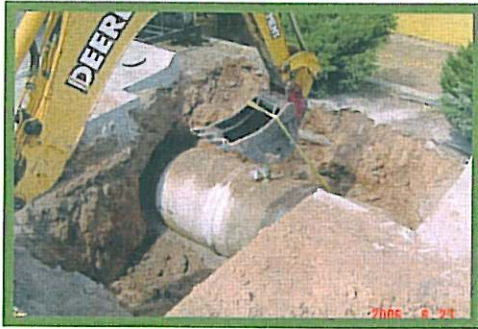


BROADWAY GAS MART

Project Description:

- The Broadway Gas Mart is a former Exxon retail fuel distribution site located in Mesa, Arizona. The site is currently active as a privately-owned fueling station facility.
- The on-site UST systems included four gasoline USTs and a waste oil UST. TDC completed UST closure for a 1000-gallon waste oil UST.
- Tanks, fill lines, dispenser lines, pump dispensers, and other ancillary UST system equipment were installed at the Broadway Gas Mart in January 1985. The site is also equipped with a service garage and hydraulic lifts.
- Project work tasks included:
 - ADEQ and Arizona State Fire Marshal permitting for UST removal;
 - Blue Stake (public) and private utilities locating (including UST and product piping);
 - Worker's Health and Safety Plan (HASP) preparation for all UST closure activities;
 - Removal and disposal of UST contents;
 - Surface cover removal;
 - Inerting, excavating, removing, and disposing of the waste oil UST;
 - Analytical soil sample collection in compliance with state and federal guidelines;
 - Waste profiling and manifesting for disposal of excavated soils, UST, and tank bottom sludge;
 - Backfill and compaction of the excavation pit;
 - Surface restoration and concrete replacement; and
 - UST closure report preparation and submittal.
